2017 Scholarship Competition

In 2017 the competition will feature live auditions for all age groups on April 1 and 2, 2017, with April 8 as a contingency date.

Eligibility: Piano students who demonstrate outstanding pianistic talent and progress while pursuing excellence in performance. Previous 1st prize winners may not compete again in the same age group. Contestants should not be relatives or students of judges, artistic advisors, Steinway Society board members or employees of Jacobs Music.

Early submission of the application form is recommended. Applications must be submitted on-line, delivered or postmarked by **February 13, 2017**. Late applications will not be accepted.

Entrance Fee: Payable to Steinway Society*

Live Audition: April 1,2, 2017 (with April 8 as a contingency date) at Jacobs Music Three judges will audition the finalists who will perform two contrasting pieces from memory. The names and qualifications of the judges will be posted on the Steinway Society website at a later date.

Please provide an original score of each piece (no photocopies) for use by the judges. Judges reserve the right not to award scholarships in all categories; their decisions will be final. Winner placements will be announced after each group.

Awards Recital: Winners will perform one piece and receive their awards during the Scholarship Musicales on April 30 2017 at Jacobs Music. Photographs will be taken following the recital. By applying to the competition, parents understand that the winners must be available to perform in the scholarship musicale. By signing the application the parent consents to the use of the student's name and photograph in connection with Steinway Society publicity.
